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


Report of Analysis of Feedback on Curriculum, Course, Teaching-Learning and Evaluation Collected From Different Stakeholders


StudentsFeedback:




Teachers Feedback:


PARENTS FEEDBACK




- Infrastructural development of the college building and completing the need of staff.

- To be started new PG programs.




Alumni Feedback:


